These vehicles were converted between different Marks. Some Mk 1 vehicles, such as mine, were built as Mk 2/3 vehicles, had the turret removed later and served as Mk 1 liaison vehicles only to have the turret replaced subsequently. Other Mk 2/3 vehicles were converted to Mk 1/1, Mk 2/4, Mk 4 and Mk 5 configurations. Mk 1 vehicles were also at various times converted to Mk 2/3 types.
